A new digital tool for piano practicing: Wolfie for Piano

Hi parents,

Don't you find that today's children are a tad too attached to any available screen they can put their hands on? The good news is that it may be possible to put this to good use. Wolfie for Piano iPad app was created to help piano students and teachers get the most out of their lessons and their practice, by leveraging the same technology that usually keeps kids distracted. This iPad app is intended to work in conjunction with actual pianos and keyboards, not "on-screen" virtual ones. After all, a screen is not a real instrument ;)

In order to connect and explore Wolfie, download the app. Ask your teacher for the invite code from his Wolfie. In the app's homepage, tap the profile icon on the top left, and have the student enter the invite code.
